Election News Update

The first LOOM Nominating Committee Meeting was held on Feb. 15th. Protocol and International Guidelines were discussed on this year's nominating procedures for elected officers. Forms have been submitted by various candidates for a number of positions already. The eligible positions of Venice LOOM Officers are; Governor, Jr. Governor, Treasurer, Prelate, 3 Year Trustee and 2 Year Trustee. The Administrator and Jr. Past Governor are not positions you can run for.

The appointed positions, by the elected Governor, are Sgt. At Arms, Inner Guard and Outer Guard.

It was voted on by the Nominating Committee and approved by the General Meeting Members on Feb. 1st to use the Australian Ballot process, which is using the paper ballot but having longer hours to cast your vote from 12:00 noon to 7:30 pm on election day April 5th. It was felt that the longer hours would allow our members more flexibility, especially those who are working shift hours. The deadline for turning in your forms for elected office is March 8th, one week prior to the date the committee is required to present its report to the Lodge. This article, along with a current list of candidates running for elected office, will be posted on the bulletin board in the hallway. Feel free to ask questions of the Nominating Committee on the Election of Officers.
